Sermon Outline:

THE PROMISES WHICH GOD HAS PROVIDED . . .

- 1. Shape the appeals we make to God (1-10)
 - a. When we ask for what God has promised to do, we ask with great confidence.
 - b. Ask for God's presence (8)
 - c. Ask for God's people to be faithful to Him (9)
 - d. Ask for God's anointed One to be central in my life (10)
- 2. Shape the answers we receive from God (11-18)
 - a. God chose his city (Zion) (13)
 - b. God has equipped his people (16)
 - c. God has revealed his anointed One (17-18)

Life Group Discussion Questions

- 1. Based on #1, above: When you pray, do you tend to pray for your own blessing, comfort and ease? Why? Is this prayer for your own advancement based on a promise? How?
- 2. Based on #1, above: How does praying for what God has promised fuel your prayer life? Have you ever prayed for God's presence to be real in your life? How did he answer that prayer?
- 3. Based on #1, above: Do you regularly pray that God's people will be faithful to Him? How has he answered that prayer?
- 4. Based on #1, above: Have you ever prayed that God's anointed one will be more central in your life? How has God answered that prayer?
- 5. Based on #2, above: How do we see the answers to the above requests (God's presence to be seen, God's people to be faithful, and God's anointed one to be revealed) on a global scale?
- 6. Based on #2, above: How can your prayer life improve in 2015?
