Life Group Sermon Summary Questions

These notes and questions are for the **August 27, 2017** sermon, "Walking in Truth." Read the sermon passage out loud together (2 John 4-8).

Sermon Outline

In matters of truth, note the context of these phrases:

- 1. Walking in the truth (v4-6)
- 2. Watch yourselves (v7-8)

Life Group Discussion Questions

- In your own words, what does it mean to "walk in the truth"?
- Pastor Gary explained that Christian truth is like a narrow path with firm parameters on both sides. What does this mean? What are some examples of the parameters that help guide the Christian life?
- Ours is a culture that celebrates the *journey* at the expense of any real destination. How have you seen this? Christianity deals very much with the ultimate destination of our journey. How does the destination inform or shape our journey?
- In verses 7-8, John once again warns about those who "have gone out from us"; those who deny the gospel or alter some core aspect of it. In what ways have you seen such "antichrists" today? What is our best tool in guarding against them and preserving the truth of the gospel?
