Discussion Questions

- Why is it important to see Jesus as the focus of the whole Bible? What dangers are there in thinking that the Bible is all about you?
- How does personal Bible application change when you see the whole Bible pointing ultimately to the person and work of Christ?
- Recount some of the historical evidence that affirms Jesus's *actual* resurrection. Why is such evidence important?
- If we don't believe in Jesus's actual resurrection, what effect might that have on other areas of life and thinking?
- How would you respond to a friend who says, "I simply can't believe in the resurrection...The New Testament accounts are myth and legend."?
- In your own words, what is the meaning of the resurrection? How does it "shatter worldviews" and transform lives?
