- 1. The favorable times to be discerned in life (v1-2)
- 2. The intense trials to be experienced in life (v3-8b)
- 3. The unfair treatments to be expected in life (v8c-10)

- 1. What impacted you from Pastor Gary's sermon? Why?
- 2. Share stories of God's faithfulness in the "favorable" times in your life.
- 3. When things are going well for us, why is it sometimes easy to lose sight of our need for God and his grace?
- 4. Share stories of God's faithfulness to you during a time of trial or hardship?
- 5. Trials, hardship, and suffering often do one of two things to people: either they can draw someone *closer* to God or else push them *away* from God. What types of things can influence either outcome?
- 6. How do you normally respond to being treated unfairly? How might the gospel shape our response to situations like this?
