SMALL GROUP SERMON SUMMARY QUESTIONS

Small Group Questions (2 Chronicles 20:14-30)

- 1. What is the "battle" that you are facing in your life today? Temptation? Medical problem? Relationship problem? Emotional burden? Financial issue?
 - NOTE: the important thing here is to NOT let one person take-over the discussion. We
 don't need to know every detail of someone's problem, just that they have identified
 their own current battle.
- 2. What promises has God made to you in His Word about your battle? What verses speak to your issue? Our lesson from Sunday was about knowing and trusting God's Word. How are you seeking to know and trust God's Word? In what ways are you seeing victory?
- 3. How are you learning to worship God *before* he intervenes? What does it look like to worship him before he intervenes?
- 4. If your battle truly belongs to the Lord, God will call you to lead with prayer and trust—not money, doctors and your own effort. What are you *leading* with? Trust in God? Or trust in self? How can you distinguish between these two opposites? (Keep in mind that God will often call us to 'fight' (use human resources such as money and doctors and effort).)
- 5. Peace is a by-product of resting in God's power. You can have peace in the midst of a storm; but you can also have anxiety on a bright, sunny day. Do you genuinely trust God's Word? How is peace (or the lack of peace) an indicator to you about your level of trust?
