

SMALL GROUP SERMON SUMMARY QUESTIONS

Watch the video summary of the **September 29, 2013 Sermon** (3.5 minutes), "No Other Gospel." Please read the sermon passage (Galatians 1:6-10) together out loud.

Small Group Questions (Galatians 1:6-10)

Sermon Outline:

1. When people begin to trust their own works (baptism, church attendance, moral goodness), teach them that Christ's death & resurrection is sufficient.
2. When people change the gospel, diagnose the change and hold to God's grace. It's not Christ's work + mine, but Christ's work alone.
3. When people make clear lines blurry, remind them of Jesus' work and empty tomb.

Small Group Discussion Questions

1. The false teachers began to teach that human works (such as circumcision) is necessary for salvation. What do your unchurched friends believe is necessary for salvation?
2. What do your religious friends tend to "add" to Christ's work? What do you tend to add to Christ's work? How can we guard against deserting the Gospel? (teach, review the Gospel often.)
3. Paul did not address the false teachers, but instead addressed his comments toward those who had claimed to be converted to Christ. How is this instructive to us today?
4. Paul used emotional language to confront his friends. He was "astonished" that they would desert the authentic gospel. Are you engaged in any emotional conversations with friends regarding the Gospel? Describe them. How can we pray for you?
5. How does this week's sermon impact your love of Jesus and his sacrifice at the cross?
