

LIFE GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Psalm 139:13-18

These questions are for the **January 19, 2025** message, **“Made Wonderfully.”** Please read the sermon passage together to set the context for our study.

Passage Outline

The LORD is...

1. The starting point of every life. (13)
2. The designer and builder of every life. (14-15)
3. Worthy of praise from every life. (16-18)

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. According to Pastor Jon, “The mother’s womb is not the origin of life—it is the location at which the Lord, Himself, knits together that life.” What does this imply about the rights of the mother and ownership of the new life?
2. Psalm 139:15 makes it clear that we are continuously “woven.” God is actively involved throughout our lives. Share with your Life Group about the impact this truth has on your view of your daily struggles and challenges?
3. Pastor Jon said that God shows us His faithfulness and goodness through those who live with challenges. Can you think of an example of a time when someone who has to live with a physical or intellectual challenge has actually caused you to see the goodness of God more clearly?
4. While we will experience perfection in heaven, the best life we can live now is under the authority of the Lord, and in submission to Him. We are called “...to choose righteousness, truth, peace, Jesus—abundant life.” What are some of the things that tend to distract you from living life with that focus? How can your Life Group pray for you as you seek to devote yourself, here and now, to Jesus?
5. Many around us are affected by pain that is the result of sin. Pastor Jon spoke of the potential impact we can have by reaching out to, patiently loving, and caring for those who are hurt and struggling. Who can you reach out to, with the intention of gently loving them in the name of Jesus? How can your Life Group encourage you as you do?
