

## LIFE GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

*Psalm 96:1-10*

These questions are for the **February 23, 2025 message**, “**Among the Nations.**” Please read the sermon passage together to set the context for our study.

### Passage Outline

The LORD reigns forever over all the earth and all the nations.

- Call to worship #1: See what the LORD is doing (1-3).
- Call to worship #2: See what the LORD has done (4-6).
- Call to worship #3: See what the LORD will do (7-10).

Hints for growing believers:

- The impact of God’s reign on our lives and words.
  - Sing - a command, from the overflowing of what God’s doing (past, present, future)
  - Tell - share the gospel
  - Declare - write it down, journal
  - Ascribe - give glory
  - Say - everyday speech
- The stark contrast between “worthless” and “worship.”

### Life Group Discussion Questions

1. As we consider how to tell of the LORD’s salvation, what are some personal examples of ways that God has saved your soul, body, purpose, and passions? Try to share some things God is doing presently (call to worship #1).
2. In what ways can you reach (and are you reaching) your neighbor with the gospel?
3. Based on verse 5, in what ways have idols in your life (pursuits, pleasures, work, etc) proved worthless? In what ways has your relationship with God shown its worth?
4. From the exhortations of this passage (sing, tell, declare, ascribe, and say) which one needs work in your life? Encourage one another as you feel led in which of these exhortations you see the Lord helping them produce.
5. Take some of your prayer time as a life group to thank God for the missionaries that we have reaching nations and people groups for the gospel of Jesus. Use the Missions Week guide to pray for the prayer requests of our missionaries.
