

These questions are for the August 10, 2025 message, "Faithfulness," from the series entitled, Fruit of the Holy Spirit. Please read the sermon passage (Daniel 3) together to set the context for our study.

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. Faithfulness is rooted in the character of God and God is always faithful. Has there ever been a time when it was hard to believe that God was faithful? How can we remind ourselves and each other of God's faithfulness during times of hardship or trouble?
2. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had a knowledge of God's word, and lived in such a way that the truth was evident in their lives. What does your time in devotion to God look like each day? Do you live out what you believe in a way that is evident to others? Are you seeking to create on ramps towards gospel conversations with those around you?
3. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego chose to remain faithful in the midst of difficult circumstances. They remained committed to God and held fast to their convictions. What are some things we can learn from their example?
4. God calls us to be faithful in every area of our lives. Is there any place you are allowing unfaithfulness or disobedience to fester? What is something God has called you to or is calling you to that you are ignoring? How can we pray for each other as we try to overcome these sins?
5. Pastor Jacob listed several different ways that faithfulness is expressed in the life of a Christian. What are some other examples? In which of these areas are you weakest? What are some practical actions you can take to grow in that area? In which of these areas do you feel you are strongest? What are some practical actions you can take to continue to grow in this area?
