These questions are for the December 28, 2025, message, "The Lord's Supper." Please read the sermon passage (1 Corinthians 11:17-26) out loud.

Passage Outline

4. Performance over Proclamation (26)

2. Reflect

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. Why do you think divisions arise in the church? How can we do a better job of being united with one another in our church? How can we do a better job of uniting with and working together with believers in other churches in the area?
2. Christ calls believers to sacrificial love. Rather than demonstrating that type of love, the Corinthian Church mistreated those on the margins. How can we, as a Life Group and as a church, do a better job of serving, loving, and helping those on the outskirts or in need?
3. Do you experience times when worship feels more like routine than relationship? How can we help one another as we strive to be more devoted worshippers?
4. As we reflect on who we are and who God is, what are our takeaways? How does this affect our worship?
5. The Lord's Supper is not only a moment of reflection, but also a moment of rejoicing. Why is joy an appropriate response to the Table? How should rejoicing in Christ's finished work shape the way we worship, serve, and live together as a church?
